The menu will include a wide variety of dishes suitable for all palates and will feature culinary delights that will be periodically changed.

"CASA SEAT is going to be a space that is open to the city and to bringing people together, and for this reason we will have a café-restaurant", explained CASA SEAT director Gabriele Palma. "Sustainability, innovation and great value for money are values shared by SEAT and Ametller Origen. We want to promote access to more sustainable mobility and to a healthier diet as well", he added.

The Ametller Origen café-restaurant at CASA SEAT will begin operating on the 23rd of April, the day the building is set to open its doors to the public.
